GENERAL ORDERS #6

TO BE READ AT MEETINGS AND POSTED:

1. Members are reminded that their annual membership in the Veterans of Foreign Wars is now subscription based and expires on their anniversary date. All officers are encouraged to make every effort to renew the membership of each and every continuous member prior to their expiration. Reports showing members 30, 60, and 90 days from expiration can be obtained by the Post Quartermaster through the Online Membership System (OMS).
2. Officers who are annual members and fail to renew prior to their expiration date will be relieved of their officer position per section 215, 415, or 515 of National By-Laws.
3. Commanders are reminded that accurate and complete records shall be kept by all persons handling Post funds including the Club Manager and Bingo Chairman. These records shall be audited by Post Trustees in the same manner as Post Quartermaster and Adjutant records.
4. Public Law 103-308, designates 7 December as National Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day and requests the flag be flown at half-staff from sunrise to sunset to honor those individuals who lost their lives that day.
5. The distribution of VFW "Buddy" Poppies will be conducted according to the provisions set forth in sections 711 of the National By-Laws and Manual of Procedure. District and Post Commanders should arrange now for distribution of "Buddy" Poppies for the Memorial Day campaign in their respective areas. All profits accruing from the distribution of "Buddy" Poppies shall be used in accordance with sections 219 and 704 of the Manual of Procedure.
6. Monthly Community Activity Reports are posted to the state website that lists the reported activity for each Post. Also there is a fillable PDF version of the report. Got to "VFWIN.ORG" and click on "COMMUNITY".
7. State HQ will be closed on 25th and 26th December 2017 to observe Christmas.
8. State HQ will be closed the 1st and 2nd January 2018 to observe New Years.
9. Several important documents are attached to these orders. Please review all.


