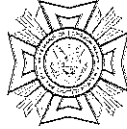


GENERAL ORDERS #4

1 October 2017
2017-18 Series

TO BE READ AT MEETINGS AND POSTED:

1. Mark your calendar and plan your work. The **31 October 2017 DEADLINE** for several VFW programs is rapidly approaching.
2. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 213 of the National By-Laws any Post in arrears for any financial obligations to District, Department and National for fees, dues, poppy money, supply money, failing to have the office of Quartermaster properly bonded in accordance with Section 703, failing to ensure that the Post is properly insured in accordance with Section 709, failing to submit properly completed quarterly Post Trustees Report of Audit, Post Election Report for the ensuing year, or other obligations, shall be deprived all representation in District meeting; District, Department and National Conventions. Such representation shall be restored promptly upon proper adjustment of such deficiencies.
3. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 215 of the National By-Laws any officer or committee member who fails to pay their current dues by their anniversary date shall forfeit their office and also forfeit eligibility to hold any office in the current administrative year.
4. State HQ will be closed on 09 October 2017 to observe Columbus Day.
5. State HQ will be closed on 30 October 2017.
6. The Finance Comm. will meet on 27 Oct., 2017, 2:00pm at the Indianapolis Marriott East Hotel.
7. The Fall Conference is 27 -29 October at the Indianapolis Marriott East Hotel. Hotel reservation form was attached to September general orders. Tentative schedule: C of A meeting at 1900 Friday (uniform State Shirt), business session beginning 0900 Saturday (uniform Blue Jacket, Tie, Grey Pants), and a banquet, 1800 Saturday (Business Casual dress).
8. Posts and Districts on a July 1 – June 30 fiscal year should file the proper federal (990) and state tax forms no later than 15 November 2017.
9. The annual Big 10 Conference is 13-15 October 2017 in Minneapolis, Minnesota. See September orders.
10. Post (and District) Trustee Report of Audit for the quarter ending 30 September 2016 is due to state headquarters no later than 31 October 2016.
