

Attention All Former (DLG/DDG) Leader Class Destroyer Veterans,

For all interested VFW and American Legion posts, please be so kind as to display this information on your event bulletin board and/or in your newsletter.

We would like to take this opportunity to extend an invitation to all U.S. Navy Veterans who have ever served aboard a Leader Class Destroyer (DLG/DDG), as well as their friends, families and survivors, to muster aboard Carnival Cruise Line's four-star, 70,367 ton super liner, Carnival Fantasy on February 12th, 2011, for a six night Destroyer (DLG/DDG) Veteran's Valentine Gathering at Sea event. The Fantasy will be sailing round-trip from historic Charleston, South Carolina and her cruise itinerary will be as follows:

As is always the case with our Gatherings at Sea, we have a friends and family policy. All survivors, families and friends (military and civilian) of those veterans who have passed on are invited to sail with us. Members of all military branches of service are also encouraged to attend.

All onboard meals, accommodations and entertainment as well as room service (24/7) will be provided. All guests from the same unit as well as those traveling with friends and families, will be seated together at the same table in the dining room each night. The entire party will also have tables grouped together in our own section of the dining room. We would be delighted to provide cakes for birthdays and anniversaries, at no cost, as long as you let us know of the occasion at least a month before sailing.

Your cruise fare, (double occupancy) all port charges and all taxes are included. There are no additional costs other than optional and personal items such as gratuities, optional shore excursions, alcoholic beverages, soft drinks and if you choose, your casino contributions! Trip cancellation, interruption and medical insurance is also optional, inexpensive and available to U.S. citizens.

Unlike cruises advertised at many internet sites, which normally are "entry level" cabins and don't include all taxes and fees, the prices below are TOTAL, including all taxes and fees, for TWO PEOPLE (not per person) sharing a stateroom. None of our cabins are "entry level". ALL are upgraded categories (6C and 4C amidships) and none of the ocean view cabins have obstructed views. We are only allocated a very limited number of upgraded cabins at these prices, so when they are gone, so are their price

guarantees:

Cat 6C Ocean View Staterooms

(Main and Upper Decks 5 & 6) \$1135.18 TOTAL for TWO people

Cat 4C Inside Staterooms

(Main and Upper Decks 5 & 6) \$1045.18 TOTAL for TWO people

If you would like to add a passenger to the above double staterooms creating a triple or quad accomodation, or if you would be interested in possibly booking a balcony suite, we would be happy to contact the cruise line for a quote for any additional persons or upgrade rate for the suites.

There is a \$250.00 per person, fully refundable deposit due at the time of booking which is applied directly to your balance. You will immediately receive an e-mail, or snail-mail confirmation if you don't have a computer. Actual stateroom assignments will be made at the time the deposit is made. This can be done with any type of debit or credit card. Cabin location requests are on a first come/first served basis, so the earlier you book, the better the availability of cabin locations. When they're gone, they are gone.

The cutoff date for group bookings will be September 15th, 2010 or whenever we run out of cabins, which ever occurs first. We are required to return all unsold group cabins to the cruiseline by that date. We will call the cruiseline for pricing and availability of cabins on any requests for bookings made after September 15th, and, if available at all, will be priced and booked at the cruiseline's going rate at that time. The final payment for the event will be November 19th, 2010. You may make payments a little at a time, as you wish, as long as your cabin is paid in full by the November 19th date. Also, so that you won't have to worry about marking your calendar, we will send out e-mail reminders and invoices periodically to keep you advised of the date and balance due.

Also, this is VERY IMPORTANT! In the event that you must cancel, all deposits will be refunded directly back to the credit card that was used for payment, 100 percent, with absolutely no penalty and no questions asked, as long as you do so before midnight on November 19th, 2010, the final payment date.
