# MEMBERSHIP PROGRAM

Membership recruitment is one of the toughest jobs there is in the VFW. Membership starts at the Post level, and it is a Post Program. We need to ensure that we involve our members in recruiting and retention. We have too many members who do not renew their membership.

Encourage members when they sign up or renew their membership to become Life Members. Members can pay the entire Life Members' dues at once or use the 12-month payment plan. There is also the option to utilize the 2-year membership as well. We are only as strong as our membership.

- For everyone to recruit at least one new member and then mentor that member.
- Increase membership drives and/or events.
- Develop new Posts and/or revitalize existing Posts.
- Increase Life Membership and Legacy Life Membership

### RECRUITER INCENTIVES

All members in good standing are eligible for Department Recruiter Awards. Recruited members must be Department of Indiana members. Award deadline is June 1, 2025. Recruiters will receive their awards and be recognized at the State Convention.

- 1-New members will receive a Commander’s-Gift.
- 3-New members will receive a Special Recruiter Pin.
- 5-New members will receive a Commander’s Coin.
- 15-New members will receive \$100.
- 25-New members will receive \$150
- 50-New members will receive \$250.
- 75-New members will receive \$350
- 100-New members will receive \$500.

These awards are cumulative and will be presented at the very next Department meeting after the level is met. In summary, if you recruit 100 new members for the Department of Indiana you will receive all the awards listed above, a cash total of \$1350.

  - ✓ Post must have participated in the State Commanders Special Project by donating \$100.

  - All Posts in District **MUST** be Inspected by March 31, 2025.
  - Must have a Voice of Democracy District entry submitted to Department.
  - Must have a Patriots Pen entry submitted to Department.
  - District must have participated in the State Commanders Special Project by donating \$100.

# MEMBER INCENTIVES

## Early Dues Payment Incentives

**All Data Must be Confirmed in VFW National Memstats**

**Continuous Member**-Any Continuous member, new member or newly reinstated member who pays their dues by the 1<sup>st</sup> of August, October, December, February, April and June will have their name placed into a drawing for \$100 for that respective month. The names will remain eligible for the next drawing unless their name is drawn.

**Life Member**-Any member who joins as a Life member, converts to a Life member or a reinstate member who converts to Life member will be placed in a drawing. If paying on an installment plan, the plan must be completely paid to be eligible. The drawing will be held at the State Convention.

- 1<sup>st</sup> name drawn - \$150
- 2<sup>nd</sup> name drawn- \$100

**Legacy Life**-Any member who becomes a Legacy Life member or advances a level (Bronze to Silver or Silver to Gold) will be placed in a drawing. If paying on installment plan, the plan must be completely paid to be eligible. If a Legacy Life member advance multiple levels, they will have an entry for each level they advance. The drawing will be held at the State Convention.

- 1<sup>st</sup> name drawn - \$250
- 2<sup>nd</sup> name drawn- \$200

## POST INCENTIVES

### Highest Percentage in Membership

The Post having the highest percentage in membership on October, 1, 2024, will receive \$100.00, two banquet tickets for the Spring Banquet and will be recognized at the Spring Conference.

The Post having the highest percentage in membership on December 1, 2024, will receive \$100.00, two banquet tickets for the Spring Banquet and will be recognized at the Spring Conference.

The Post having the highest percentage in membership on February 1, 2025, will receive \$100.00, two banquet tickets for the Spring Banquet and will be recognized at the Spring Conference.

The Post having the highest percentage in membership on April 1, 2025, will receive \$100.00, two banquet tickets for the State Convention and will be recognized at the State Convention.

## **102% In Membership**

Post achieving 102% in membership prior to December 29, 2024 will be put in a drawing for \$300.00 and will be recognized at the Spring Conference.

All Posts achieving 102% in membership prior to December 29, 2024 will receive two banquet tickets for the Spring Banquet and will be recognized at the Spring Conference.

The leading Post by Division whose Post has at least 10 new members and has 102% membership by June 1, 2025, will receive \$200.00 and will be formally recognized at the State Convention.

## **Post Quartermaster Awards**

The Team Captain of the All-State Post Quartermasters will receive the Orval B Holycross Award.

# **DISTRICT INCENTIVES**

**District Incentive**-Any District that has every post recruit at least one new member by December 1, 2024, will receive \$1,000 to their district funds. If achieved after January 1, 2025, and before May 1, 2025, the District will receive \$500 to their district funds.

## **Highest Percentage in Membership**

Any District with at least 90% by December 15, 2024, will receive \$200.00, four banquet tickets for the Spring Banquet and will be recognized at the Spring Conference.

## **District Commanders Awards**

District Commanders who attain 102% in membership by June 1, 2025 and had a School of Instruction by October 1, 2024 will receive a \$200.00 award.

For a District Commander to be a Round Robin Commander, all posts must be 101% in membership. If they achieve this by May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2025 they will be recognized at the State Convention. If a District Commander becomes Round Robin after May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2025, they will receive their awards later.

\*Final decision will be at the State Commander's discretion.
