

GENERAL ORDERS #10

1 April 2023 2022-2023 Series

TO BE READ AT MEETINGS AND POSTED:

1. INSTALLING OFFICERS: Installing officers will see that the provisions of Section 216 of the National Bylaws and the Manual of Procedures are properly conducted and that all officers are members in good standing and qualified to hold office prior to installing Post officers for the current year. Post officers shall not be installed or assume the duties of their office until proof of eligibility has been submitted and properly reviewed.

Post Election Reports must be submitted following Post elections of officers in April and no later than 1 June to the National Headquarters. We highly encourage all Post Quartermasters to use the online Election Report process featured in the Online Membership System (OMS). Post Election Reports received electronically will be forwarded to the Department Headquarters.

2. VFW NATIONAL CONVENTION REGISTRATION: Attention of Post Commanders is directed to Section 222 of the National Bylaws and the Manual of Procedure, which provided that each Post will pay, in advance, a National Convention registration fee of twenty-five (\$25) which shall entitle the Post to a packet of convention information and materials and one identified registered delegate for the National Convention. Each additional delegate attending the National Convention will pay a ten-dollar (\$10) delegate fee.

Posts are encouraged to register their Post delegate online through the Online Membership System (OMS) or by submitting their National Convention Post and Delegate Registration form that was mailed to all Posts as part of the Election Report/Convention Registration mailing that went out in February. Advanced registration for the 124th National Convention should be mailed with each delegate's name and address to: Convention Registration, 406 W. 34th Street, Kansas City, MO 64111.

- 3. **VFW NATIONAL CONVENTION HOUSING:** Indiana has been assigned the Sheraton for the Phoenix, AZ Convention. Room reservations/ Housing forms can be found at **www.vfw.org**.
- 4. **DISTRICT CONVENTION:** Pursuant to Section 403 of the National Bylaws and the Manual of Procedure, each District shall hold an annual District Convention for the purpose of electing District officers, such convention to held not less than (10) days nor more than seventy-five (75) days prior to the convening of the Department Convention. District officers shall not assume the duties of their office until the Department Commander is installed. District officers shall not be installed or assume the duties of their office until proof of eligibility has been submitted and carefully reviewed in accordance with Section 416 of the Manual of Procedure.
- 5. STATE CONVENTION: Will be held at the Marriott East, Indianapolis, IN. The dates are 8 11 June 2023. Please make note of these important dates, making sure that all Posts are up to date on all reports and monies due to Districts, State and National. See attachment for Room Reservations. District Quartermaster's are required to send to the State Adjutant the Authorizations Sheet for the Marriott, you may email adj@vfwin.org or Fax (317)377-1797.

All Commanders/Quartermasters: In accordance with Sec 213 of the National Bylaws, Any Post in arrears for any financial obligations to County Council (if applicable), District, Department and National for fees, dues, poppy money, supply money, failing to have the Quartermaster properly bonded in accordance with Section 703, failing to ensure the Post is properly insured in accordance with Section 709, failing to submit properly completed quarterly Post Trustees Report of Audit, Post-Election Report for the ensuing year, or other obligations, shall be deprived of all representation in County Council and District meetings; County Council, District, Department and National Conventions. Such representation shall be restored promptly upon proper adjustment of such deficiencies.

All deficiencies must be corrected with the State Adjutant before NCON ON FRIDAY 9 JUNE 2023.

- 6. STATE CONVENTION DELEGATES: State Convention Delegate list is attached. A Post is entitled to 1 delegate for 30 members or fraction thereof. Based on membership numbers as of 31 March 2023. Delegate fee to State is based on the 1 per 30 ratios plus one (1) for the Commander. If your members are 187 that equals 6.24, rounded to 7 plus 1 for the Commander, for a total of 8 delegates. This product times the \$3.00 delegate fee equates to \$24.00 to the State. Delegate fees are to be paid on or before 1 June 2023 to the Department Headquarters.
- 7. **ADMIN FEES:** Each Post will pay an administrative fee of \$1.00 for every **NEW** member attained from 1 July 2022 through the date of the Post-Election. Admin fees are to be paid on or before 1 June 2023 to the Department Headquarters.
- 8. LOYALTY DAY AND MEMORIAL DAY OBSERVANCE: Section 223 of the National Bylaws and the Manual of Procedure provides that each Post shall make the necessary arrangements for proper observance of Loyalty Day and Memorial Day. Officers should see that suitable grave markers, wreaths and flags of the United States are placed on the graves of deceased veterans.

2. DEPARTMENT PROGRAM DEADLINE DATES

- All State The nomination for All State Post Commander and Quartermaster is included in these General Orders. The deadline for submission for submission for All State Nominations and related documentation is Noon on 24 April 2023. All materials must be at the VFW State Headquarters at this time.
- James Butters Award The James Butters Award is an annual award that goes to a deserving Post Service Officer. The nomination form for this is included within these documents. The deadline for submission is 30 April 2023. Submit nominations to the State Adjutant at adj@vfwin.org.
- Keiston Holloway Chaplain of the Year Award The Keiston Holloway Chaplain of the Year Award is an annual award to Honor Post and District Chaplains for their commitment and service to our Veterans. Please see the nomination form for this is included within these documents. The deadline for submission is 30 April 2023. Submit nominations to the State Chaplain at jerryoblake@gmail.com.
- Loyalty Day Parades Based on submissions received by 31 May 2023. Submission should include a narrative of the parade, number of Post participating, any State officers, pictures, and estimated public attendance. The Post that sponsors the District Parade in eligible for the Post Award.

- Post Publication Award Based on submissions received by 31 May 2023. Submission should have copies of publications for the previous year, prefer electronic version. Include name of editor.
- Honor/Color Guard Award Based on submissions received by 31 May 2023. Submission should include pictures of events, funeral ceremonies, and parades. Number and type of events.
- Scharrfin Award Post with the most attendees at the annual Indiana National Home Day and with the largest donation to the National Home. Submission should include a picture of attendees at the National Home and proof of donation from the National Home. Winner is decided on a point system, one point for each Post member present and one point for each \$100.00 or portion of. Example 9 members attended, and the Post donated \$2356.00. 9 points for member and \$2356/100=23.56 round up to 24, total points equal 33.
- Indiana Veterans Home Award Post with the most attendees at the annual Indiana Veterans Home Day and with the largest donation to the Indiana Veterans Home. Submission should include picture of attendees at the Indiana Veterans Home and proof of donation from Indiana Veterans Home. Winner is decided on a point system, one point for each Post member present and one point for each \$100.00 or portion of. Example 9 members attended, and the Post donated \$2356.00. 9 points for members and \$2356/100=23.56 round up to 24, total points equal 33.



ALL STATE PROGRAM

ALL STATE POST PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

The requirements for All Sate Post must be completed by June 30, 2023. For a Post to be recognized and receive their awards at the State Convention it will be necessary for the Post to meet the All State requirements by April 21, 2023. The packet must be at Department HQ by 12:00pm (noon) of April 24, 2023. Post who complete the All State requirements after April 21, 2023 will receive their recognition and awards at the 2023 Fall Conference, packet must be at Department HQ July 7, 2023. Post Commander and Post Quartermaster must serve a complete term to be eligible for All State honors, exceptions must be approved by Department Commander prior to submission of All State Post packet.

The All State Post program is based on point system, to achieve All State you will need a total of 2500 points out of the 3125 available. The All State entry form has the different point values for each requirement, a score sheet is available for your convenience.

The All State Post Packet must include the entry form, along with any other supporting documentation should be emailed to the Department Adjutant, adj@vfwin.org. It can be sent by US Mail (must be mailed early to meet the deadline) or personally delivered to VFW Department Headquarters. To ensure your awards are available at the Department Convention the packet must meet the deadlines noted above. The Commander and a committee of Past Commanders will review all entries.

1. ALL STATE LETTERS

275 POINTS

The All State Letters are to encourage you to talk with comrades who have been Post Commanders:

- A letter from the current or a past District Commander recommending the Post for All State Honors.
- The Post Commander must include a letter stating how the Post was able to achieve All State status.
- A log sheet with signatures of distinguished people, both VFW and civilians who either visited the Post or the Commander spoke with during their year as Commander.

2. 100% Membership

1000 Points

The Post must achieve 100% in membership by June 30, 2023. Plus the following requirements:

- Have recovered at least 1 reinstate.
- Have recruited at least 1 new member.

3. Post Commitment to District and Department

250 Points

The Post Commander or a designee from the Post must attend the following:

- All properly scheduled District meetings.
- Must attend two of the following Department events School of Instruction, Fall Conference, Spring Conference or Department Convention.

4. RECRUITING EVENT

100 POINTS

The Post must have at least one documented recruiting event in their local community, prior to May 19, 2023. See reporting requirement on All State entry form.

5. VFW PROGRAMS

700 POINTS

The Post must show participation in the following:

- Voice of Democracy at least one entry submitted to your District
- Patriot's Pen at least one entry submitted to your District
- Teacher of the Year at least one K-12 entry submitted to your District
- Buddy Poppies must order at least 5 per member and must report at least one
 Buddy Poppy event. See reporting requirement on All State entry form.
- Community Service Must complete monthly Community Service Reports as require by the Department Community Service Chairperson

6. POST STEWARDSHIP

300 POINTS

To ensure the Post is prepared for the future the following good stewardship items must be completed:

- Post Inspection Post Inspection must be completed prior to March 15, 2023 and any deficiencies must be corrected by April 7, 2023 or have a detailed plan to correct.
- Post Trustee Audits Post must be current on Trustee Audits.
- Post Membership Meetings Post must have had at least one membership meeting each month since July 1, 2022 or a letter from the District Commander justifying any missing meetings.
- Post House Committee Any Post with a canteen/clubroom must have a properly elected and functioning House Committee.

7. CHARITABLE DONATIONS

500 Points

The Post must contribute to the following charitable organizations: Preferable the Post will hold a fund raiser in the community for each of these worthy causes.

- Commander's Special Project Veterans Foundation of Indiana
 - Division 8,9,10,11 Post donation must equal \$1.00 per member or \$50.00
 - Division 4,5,6,7 Post donation must equal \$1.00 per member or \$100.00

- Division 1,2,3 Post donation must equal \$1.00 per member or \$150.00
- Indiana Veterans Home An amount (more than \$25.00) <u>approved</u> by Post membership.
- VFW National Home for Children An amount (more than \$25.00) <u>approved</u> by Post membership.
- Veterans & Military Support Coordinate and hold at least one charitable event with the proceeds donated to Veterans & Military Support program, minimum donation \$100.00

ALL STATE DISTRICT PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

The requirements for All Sate District must be completed by June 30, 2023. For a District to be recognized and receive their awards at the State Convention it will be necessary for the District to meet the All State requirements by April 21, 2023. The packet must be at Department HQ by 12:00pm (noon) of April 24, 2023. Districts who complete the All State requirements after April 21, 2023 will receive their recognition and awards at the 2023 Fall Conference, packet must be at Department HQ July 7, 2023. District Commander must serve a complete term to be eligible for All State honors, exceptions must be approved by Department Commander prior to submission of All State packet.

The All State District program is based on point system, to achieve All State you will need a total of 2100 points out of the 2725 available. The All State entry form has the different point values for each requirement, a score sheet is available for your convenience.

The All State District Packet must include the entry form, along with any other supporting documentation should be emailed to the Department Adjutant, adj@vfwin.org. It can be sent by US Mail (must be mailed early to meet the deadline) or personally delivered to VFW Department Headquarters. To ensure your awards are available at the Department Convention the packet must meet the deadlines noted above. The Commander and a committee of Past Commanders will review all entries.

1. ALL STATE DISTRICT LETTERS

475 Points

The All State Letters are to encourage you to talk with comrades who have been District Commanders:

- A letter from a past District Commander or one of the District's Post Commanders recommending the District for All State Honors.
- The District Commander must include a letter stating how the District was able to achieve All State status.
- A log sheet with signatures of distinguished people, both VFW and civilian who the Commander spoke with during their year as Commander.
- Submit an article to the Department newsletter Combat Vet, each quarter or as needed by the editor of the newsletter. This doesn't have to be a full page but at least a paragraph and perhaps some picture(s).

2. 100% MEMBERSHIP

1000 POINTS

The District must achieve 100% in membership by June 30, 2023. Plus the following requirements:

- Have recovered at least 3 reinstates.
- Have recruited at least 3 new members.

3. DISTRICT COMMITMENT TO DEPARTMENT

250 POINTS

The District Commander or a designee from the District must attend the following:

- All properly scheduled Department Council of Administration meetings.
- Must attend all of the following Department events School of Instruction, Fall Conference, Winter C of A, Spring Conference or Department Convention.

4. Loyalty Day

200 Points

The District must plan and have a Loyalty Day event.

5. VFW PROGRAMS

375 Points

The District must show participation in the following:

- Voice of Democracy at least one entry submitted to the Department
- Patriot's Pen at least one entry submitted to the Department
- Teacher of the Year at least one K-12 entry submitted to the Department
- National Home for Children Attend or have a representative attend Indiana Day at the Home.

6. DISTRICT STEWARDSHIP

425 POINTS

To ensure the District is prepared for the future the following good stewardship items must be completed:

- District Inspection District Inspection must be completed prior to February 28, 2023 and any deficiencies must be corrected by April 14, 2023 or have a detailed plan to correct. If District inspection isn't complete then a letter from the Department Inspector must be submitted with an explanation as to why not.

- Insure that all Post Inspections within your District are completed by March 15, 2023.




