

TO BE READ AT MEETINGS AND POSTED:

1. INSTALLING OFFICERS: will see that the provisions of Section 216 of the National Bylaws and the Manual of Procedure are properly conducted and that all officers are members in good standing and qualified to hold office prior to installing Post officers for the current year. Post officers shall not be installed or assume the duties of their office until proof of eligibility has been submitted and properly reviewed.

Post Election Reports must be submitted following Post elections of officers in April and no later than 1 June to the National Headquarters. We highly encourage all Post Quartermasters to use the online Election Report process featured in the Online Membership System (OMS). Post Election Reports received electronically will be forwarded to the Department Headquarters.

2. VFW NATIONAL CONVENTION REGISTRATION: Attention of Post Commanders is directed to Section 222 of the National Bylaws and the Manual of Procedure, which provided that each Post will pay in advance, a National Convention registration fee of twenty-five (\$25) which shall entitle the Post to a packet of convention information and materials and one identified registered delegate for the National Convention will pay a tendollar (\$10) delegate fee.

Post are encouraged to register their Post delegate online through the OMS or by submitting their National Convention Post and Delegate Registration form that was mailed to all Posts as part of the Election Report/Convention Registration mailing that went out in February. Advanced registration for the 125th National Convention should be mailed with each delegate's name and address to: Convention Registration, 406 W. 34th Street, Kansas City, MO 64111.

3. **VFW NATIONAL CONVENTION HOUSING:** Indiana has been assigned the Hyatt Regency for the Louisville, KY Convention. Room reservations/Housing forms can be found at www.vfw.org.

- 4. DISTRICT CONVENTION: Pursuant to Section 403 of the National Bylaws and the Manual of Procedure each District shall hold an annual District Convention of the purpose of electing District Officers, such convention to held not less than ten (10) days nor more the seventy-five (75) days prior to the convening for the Department Convention. District officers shall not assume the duties of their office until the Department Commander is installed. District officers shall not be installed or assume the duties of their office until proof of eligibility has been submitted and carefully reviewed in accordance with Section 416 of the Manual of Procedure.
- 5. STATE CONVENTION: Will be held at the Marriot East, Indianapolis, IN. The dates are 13 16 June 2024. Please make note of these important dates, making sure that all Posts are up to date on all reports and monies due to Districts, State and National. See attachment for Room Reservations. District Quartermaster's are required to send to the State Adjutant the Authorization Sheet for the Marriott, you may email adj@vfwin.org or Fax (317)377-1797.
- All Commanders/Quartermasters: In accordance with Sec 213 of the National Bylaws, Any Post in arrears for any financial obligations to County Council (if applicable), District, Department and National for fees, dues, poppy money, supply money, failing to have the Quartermaster properly bonded in accordance with Section 703, failing to ensure the Post is properly insured in accordance with Section 709, failing to submit properly completed quarterly Post Trustees Report of Audit, Post-Election Report for the ensuing year, or other obligations, shall be deprived of all representation in County Council and District meetings; County Council, District, Department and National Conventions. Such representation shall be restored promptly upon proper adjustment of such deficiencies.

All deficiencies must be corrected with the State Adjutant before NOON ON FRIDAY 14 JUNE 2024.

6. STATE CONVENTION DELEGATES: list is attached. A Post is entitled to 1 delegate for 30 members or fraction thereof. Based on membership numbers as of 31 March 2024. Delegate fees to State is based on the 1 per 30 ratios plus one (1) for the Commander. If your members are 187 that equals 6.24, rounded to

7 plus 1 for the Commander, for a total of 8 delegates. This product time the \$3.00 delegate fee equates to \$24.00 to the State. Delegate fees are to be paid on or before 1 June 2024 to the Department Headquarters.

- 7. LOYALTY DAY AND MEMORIAL DAY OBSERVANCE: Section 223 of the National Bylaws and the Manual of Procedure provides that each Post shall make the necessary arrangements for proper observance of Loyalty Day and Memorial Day. Officers should see that suitable grave markers, wreaths and flags of the United States are place on the graves of deceased veterans.
- 8. COCKTAILS WITH THE COMMANDER: will be every 3rd Wednesday of the month at 7pm. The next zoom meeting will be 17 April 2024.

Premier Arms in Brownsburg held a fundraiser for my special project in the fall. During the Spring Conference the owners, JoLee and Bryce Curry presented a check for \$34,000 to the VFW State of Indiana. This money is going towards my special project "Suicide Awareness." Several VFW Posts donated checks as well. All these funds will be donated to CAV Art (Creative Art for Veterans) and Mission 22.

Our Membership Recruiters are doing a great job. We handed out over \$2000 in membership awards. At the Spring Conference. Thank you to all our Recruiters for wearing your "RED" recruiting t-shirts. To be eligible for a "RED" recruiting t-shirt, just recruit one new or reinstate member. We currently have 207 active recruiters in our state. That is up from 174 recruiters at the end of February. Our membership percentage rose from 92.13 to 95.21%.

102% Membership Is coming directly from the National Commander-in-Chief.

To achieve 102.01% (Indiana goal) we need to add 1,697+1 New and/or Reinstated Members to our ranks prior to 30 June. It takes approximately 243 members to move up 1% point. We need to be recruiting at the rate of 18.7 new joins per day to be successful.

INCENTIVES

Early Dues Payment Incentives

(All Data Must be Confirmed in VFW National Memstats)

Continuous Member-Any Continuous member, new member or newly reinstated member who pays their dues by Dec 30, 2023, will have their name placed into a drawing for \$100. Unless their name is drawn, the names will remain eligible for the next drawing.

District Incentive-Any District that has every post recruit at least one new member by December 1, 2023, will receive \$1,000 to their district funds. If achieved after December 1, 2023, and before May 1, 2024, the District will receive \$750 to their district funds.

Legacy Life-Any member who becomes a Legacy Life member or advances a level (Bronze to Silver or Silver to Gold) will be placed in a drawing. If paying on installment plan, the plan must be completely paid to be eligible. If a Legacy Life member advance multiple levels they will have an entry for each level they advance. The drawing will be held at the **2024 State Convention**.

- 1st name drawn \$200
- 2nd name drawn- \$250

Life Member-Any member who joins as a Life member, converts to a Life member or a reinstate member who converts to Life member will be placed in a drawing. If paying by an installment plan the plan must be completely paid to be eligible. The drawing will be held at the 2024 State Convention.

- 1st name drawn \$100
- 2nd name drawn- \$150

RECRUITER INCENTIVES

All members in good standing are eligible for Department Recruiter Awards. Recruited members must be *Department of Indiana members*. Award deadline is June 1, 2024. Recruiters will receive their awards and be recognized at the State Convention.

- 10-New or reinstated members will receive a Commander's-Gift & certificate.
- 15-New or reinstated members will receive a Commanders Coin and \$75.00.
- 25-New or reinstated members will receive a Commander's-Gift and \$150.00.
- 50-New or reinstated members will receive \$250.00.
- 75-New or reinstated members will receive a \$350.00 stipend to the National Convention.
- 100-New or reinstated members will receive a \$500.00 stipend to the National Convention.

These awards are cumulative and will be presented at the very next Department meeting after the level is met. In summary, if you recruit 100 new or reinstated members for the Department of Indiana you will receive all the awards listed above, a cash total of \$1325.00. If you receive another stipend to the National convention, you will receive the recruiter award for \$75 and \$100 in CASH, but you must attend the National Convention to receive the cash award.
