- 5. **ALL ELECTED AND APPOINTED STATE OFFICERS** must submit proof of eligibility to the State Adjutant immediately if you were not a State Officer in 2020-2021. This includes District Commanders. If in doubt send it in.
- 6. State Headquarters will be closed on 5 July 2021.
- 7. **All Posts** are hereby directed that they will adhere to National and State By-Laws, Manual of Procedures, and Ritual.
- 8. **Post Commanders:** Attention of incoming Post Officers is directed to Section 218 of the Manual of Procedures which outlines the duties of various Post Officers. Please make sure that you provide a copy of the duties to these Officers so that you may have a successful year.
- 9. Post Commanders and Quartermasters are reminded that post elections were to have been completed in April, per by-law, and Election Reports need to be filed immediately with National.
- On 1 July 2021, the Commander-in-Chief will issue a directive to each Department, in the form of a special order, directing the suspension of any Post with the continued arrearage (i.e.,

- Election Reports, Money Due, Quarterly Audits, Bonds...etc.). Suspension is not only time consuming but take away other valuable resources from the Department. Post charters under suspension and failing to submit an elelcti9oon report under this order will be subject to revocation.
- 10. **Post Commanders:** Section 218 of the Manual of Procedure requires that the Post Commander shall see that the Post Trustees Reports of Audit are properly prepared and submitted each quarter to the State Quartermaster.
- 11. Post (and District) Trustee Report of Audit for the quarter ended 30 June 2021 is due to State Headquarters not later than 31 July 2021. Post not in compliance will be put on suspension.
- 12. District/Post Commanders: Attention is called to the provisions of Section 703 of the National By-Laws: Each officer accountable for funds or property pursuant to any provision of these By-Laws shall be bonded with an indemnity company as surety in a sum at least equal to the amount of the liquid assets for which, so far as can be anticipated, may be accountable. The bond premium shall be paid from the funds of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States, Department, District, County Council or Post to which each officer is accountable. The bonds of such accountable officers, in amount and as to surety, shall be approved by their respective units and be held by their respective Commanders. The Commander of each unit shall be responsible for the proper and adequate bonding of all accountable Officers in the unit.
- 13. **District Quartermasters** are directed to Article VI of the Department By-Laws that they shall submit to the State Quartermaster within sixty (60) days after their District Convention, a copy of the District Budget for the ensuing year.
- 14. **C** of A and Committee Members: District Commanders are reminded that in case you are unable to attend the C of A meeting that a representative be present in your place. All C of A and Committee members are advised that you must notify both the State Commander and the State Adjutant if you are unable to attend a Council of Administration meeting/Business Session meeting for the year 2021-2022. Also, a copy of your report MUST be forwarded to the State Adjutant office prior to

the meeting for presentation at the meeting and inclusion in the minutes.

- 2021 School of Instruction is Saturday 14 August 2021 at the Indianapolis Marriott Center East. Post Commanders, Quartermasters and Trustees are HIGHLY encouraged to attend. Registration is \$20.00 per person, which includes lunch. Registration will be open Saturday morning at 0800. Please see attachment. All Quartermasters/Adjutants, at least 1 Trustee and the Post Commander need to attend. This year's goal is to have all QM/ADJ/Trustees on the same sheet of music. No matter if you have been in the position for 1 year or 20 years QM's will be behind the curve if they do not attend this upcoming training. All Quartermasters need to contact National Headquarters prior to this training so that they are available to access specific reports not available to all members. Only National HQ can assign you a log-in to Troop ID. We are also reaching out to Charity Gaming and State Excise to have them provide any new laws/procedures that affect the Posts.
- 16. Commander's Special Project: Honor Flight of Indiana.
- 17. State Commander Special Visit Request: Post's wishing to have the State Commander attend Post functions are to contact the State Headquarters at least 4 weeks in advance to give time for the invitation to be scheduled for the State Commanders.



Please find enclosed new simplified bond applications for bonding Club Managers, Bingo Chairmen or Club Employees. <u>A new application must be submitted each year.</u> These supplies are for the bond term of October 1, 2021 to September 30, 2022. These applications can be photocopied for additional supplies. Also enclosed are the consolidated forms #4 for transmittal to this office. <u>PLEASE ISSUE A SEPARATE CHECK FOR THE CLUB MANAGERS.</u> DO NOT INCLUDE WITH THE QUARTERMASTER BOND CHECK.

#### PLEASE READ THE INSTRUCTIONS TO COMPLETE THE CHANGES FOR THE UPCOMING BOND YEAR 20/21.

- The application needs to be completed in full, such as the Post Income and answering all of the questions.
- 2. The application that the post completes will have to be returned to this office, along with the completed consolidation application and check for the premium.
- If Bond is not renewed, terminated, or cancelled at Expiration Date of 10-1-2021, the
  post has only 90 days to submit a proof of loss for prior term, after 90 days prior
  coverage ceases.

If the Consolidated Application from the Department is postmarked by November 30, 2021, the effective date will be October 1, 2021.

We will accept bonds after November 30, 2021 as per procedures below.

Any Consolidated Application received in **December** and mailed to our office with a postmark date by **December 31, 2021**, will be effective **December 1, 2021** and I will send you a Certificate with dates of **December 1, 2021 to September 30, 2022** so you can complete and send to your posts.

Any Consolidated Application received in **January** and mailed to our office with a postmark date by **January 31, 2022**, will be effective **January 1, 2022** and I will send you a Certificate with dates of **January 1, 2022** to **September 30, 2022** so you can complete and send to your posts.

The same will be for **February** as above, any consolidated application received in **February** and mailed to our office with a postmark date by **February 28**, **2022** will be effective **February 1**, **2022** and I will send you a Certificate with dates of **February 1**, **2022 to September 30**, **2022**.

The same procedure will be done as above for March, April, May and June. I will not be able to accept any bonds after May 31, 2022.

In December 2019, I will send the Certificates to you for the various dates above for each month so you will have them to complete for the posts that are late getting their bonds in.

<u>Travelers is emphasizing the importance of getting the bonds to our office before November</u> 30, 2020, this will minimize the post not having proper bond coverage at time of loss.

The By-laws, Section 703, states that each accountable officer of the organization shall be bonded. All officers and committee chairmen handling post monies are required to be bonded.

Please remember that the bond is a Named Position Schedule Bond protecting the position of Club Manager and other Club Employees and Volunteers such as bartender, bar manager, canteen manager or house chairmen. This bond also can protect any <a href="Legal">Legal</a> Gambling operations such as Bingo, Games of Chance and Slot Machines. If there is more than one person the club wishes to bond, they merely identify their position, fill out the application and send it to us with the individual premium per person. They will be added to our master bond with the National Headquarters.

If you have any questions or if we can be of further help, please advise. Thank you for the opportunity to serve you for the 2021/2022 bond year.

Application for VFW Accountable Officers Crime Coverage

August 1, 2021

One of the most important communications you will receive during the year concerns the bond of your Unit Quartermaster. Section 703 of our National By-Laws requires that each accountable officer shall be bonded with an Indemnity Company as surety and the By-Laws places the responsibility for adequate bonding upon the Commander of the post. In any business it is customary to bond any officer handling funds. THE BOOKS AND RECORDS OF THE ACCOUNTABLE OFFICER MUST BE AUDITED AT LEAST QUARTERLY BY THE TRUSTEES. THIS IS TO COMPLY WITH SECTION 218 OF THE NATIONAL MANUAL OF PROCEDURES.

The Department Headquarters carries a schedule bond for the bonding of Department and Post Accountable Officers. This bond runs for a year – from September 1 to August 31 – premium payments are made on that basis. All bonds expire on August 31 and premium for New Year is due on September 1.

Any unit may decide whether it prefers to take out a bond with some other surety company or have its funds protected by the Department Headquarters schedule bond. But the matter should be given prompt attention because if your Accountable Officer had previously been bonded through the National Headquarters, a new premium payment is required by September 1, 2021 and delinquent after this date.

IF BOND IS NOT RENEWED, TERMINATED, OR CANCELLED AT EXPIRATION DATE OF 9-1-2021, THE POST HAS ONLY 90 DAYS TO SUBMIT A PROOF OF LOSS FOR PRIOR TERM, AFTER 90 DAYS PRIOR COVERAGE CEASES.

#### COVERAGES OF THE POLICY REQUIRE THAT:

- 1. You agree to make/or cause to be made, at least annually, an audit of your books and accounts, including complete verification of all securities and bank balances pertaining to each "employee and/ or volunteer".
  - If the above is not complied with, the Surety Company will refuse to honor claim of missing funds which cannot be proven by records. Monthly audits and reconciliation of bank statements may avoid this denial of claim.
- 2. The Surety Company will not pay for loss resulting from any unauthorized advances made by an "employee" to any member for delinquent dues and assessments.
- 3. "Employee" means any duly elected position or any appointed officer as listed in the policy schedule.
- 4. POST MUST SUBMIT A PROOF OF LOSS FORM WITHIN 120 DAYS FROM THE FIRST DATE OF DISCOVERY OF THE LOSS. Proof of loss resulting from dishonest acts on the part of the bonded officer is required in settlement of claims.

THIS BOND IS ONLY FOR THE YEAR SEPTEMBER 1, 2021 TO AUGUST 31, 2022.

The funds of your Post are protected only for that year. Premium for the following year will be due September 1, 2022.


