GENERAL ORDERS #3

1 September 2018 2018-19 Series

TO BE READ AT MEETINGS AND POSTED:

- 1. Post Quartermaster Bonds obtained from the Department through National expired on 31 August 2018. Application for bond renewal was attached to August General Orders. Please get these turned in to the Department Headquarters ASAP.
- 2. Organizations exempt from income tax under Section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code are generally required to file Form 990 by the 15th day of the fifth month following the close of their accounting fiscal year. For the current IRS requirements (beginning on or after January 1), if the organization's annual gross receipts are normally more than \$50,000, the organization must file Form 990 or 990-EZ. Small tax-exempt organizations whose annual gross receipts are normally \$50,000 or less are required to electronically submit Form 990-N, also known as the e-Postcard. There is no penalty assessment for late filling the e-Postcard, but an organization that fails to file required information returns for three consecutive years will automatically lose its tax-exempt status. The revocation of the organization's tax exempt status will not take place until the filing due date of the third year.

Gross receipts are considered to be normally less than \$50,000 if the organization:

- 1. Has been in existence for 1 year or less and received, or donors have pledged to give, \$75,000 or less during its first taxable year;
- 2. Has been in existence between 1 and 3 years and averaged \$60,000 or less in gross receipts during each of its first two tax years; and
- 3. Is at least 3 years old and averaged \$50,000 or less in gross receipts for the immediately preceding 3 tax years (including the year for which the calculations are being made).

If annual gross receipts are normally more than \$50,000, the organization must file Form 990 or 990-EZ. For the current IRS requirements, if an organization has gross receipts less than \$200,000 and total assets less than \$500,000, it may file form 990-EZ. However, if either gross receipts or total assets are above those limits, Form 990 must be filed.

For purposes of filing requirements, gross receipts include: total contributions; gifts and grants; program service revenue; membership dues and assessments; gross investment income (including interest, dividends, gross rents, and other investment income); gross income from the sale of assets other than inventory; gross income from special fundraising events; gross sales net of return allowances; and any other revenue.

IRS regulations require that all tax-exempt organizations make both their Application for Exemption and 990's for the last three years available for public inspection at their principal office and provide copies in response to written requests, subject to the payment of reasonable fees. There are substantial penalties for violation of these regulations.

- 3. All Commanders are reminded that Section 709, Manual of Procedure Control of Units, requires that any activity, clubroom, holding company or unit sponsored, conducted or operated by, for or in behalf of a Post, County Council, District or Department shall be at all times under the direct control of such Post, County Council, District or Department and that all money, property or assets of any kind or nature, must be placed in the care and custody of the respective Quartermaster. All Commanders should ensure that all provisions of Section 709 are enforced.
- 4. The attention of Department, District, County Council and Post Commanders is directed to Section 103, Manual of Procedure, which prescribes the manner in which applications for membership will be handled. Applications for membership of new, reinstating or transfer members must be voted on by the members present at a regular Post meeting. No Post, County Council, District, Department or National officer, or any other member, has authority to reject the application card of a person who is eligible for membership.
- 5. As a matter of protocol, it is inappropriate to schedule a Post function/activity/special event that conflicts with an event of the District or the Department. Accordingly, it is inappropriate for a District to schedule conflicts with Department events.
- 6. Commander Eric Billmans' picture is now on the state website "www.vfwin.org".
- 7. Quartermasters are reminded to check their Post VMAIL to receive important communications and ACH notifications from VFW National Headquarters.
- 8. State HQ will be closed on 3 September to observe Labor Day.
- 9. National POW/MIA day is 21 September 2018.
- 10. Indiana Day at the VFW National Home for Children in Eaton Rapids, Michigan is Sunday, September 23, 2018. Events get underway at 0900. Lunch at 1200.
- 11. State Campout is scheduled for 27-30 September 2018. Information is attached to the August General Orders.
- 12. The official birth date of the VFW is 29 September 1899. Please do something special in your Post/District to mark the occasion.
- 13. Deadline for Combat Veteran is 6 October 2018. Please submit material.
- 14. VFW Day at the Indiana Veterans Home in West Lafayette is Sunday 14 October 2018.

- 15. The annual Big 10 Conference is 19 & 20 October 2018 in St. Louis, MO. Room reservations should be made by 13 September. Advance registration is \$100.00. - 1. Remission of fees for Disabled Veteran's children attending State schools.
- 2. Veterans who are in the VA's Individual Unemployability category and the spouse of a Veteran Killed in Action (KIA) should receive the same property tax exemption as a Veteran rated at 100% disabled.
- 3. Provide legislation to allow electronic gaming terminals in Congressionally Chartered Veterans Service Organizations facilities.
- 4. Designate a percentage of lottery ticket revenue to fund State Veterans programs.
- 5. Indiana income tax exemption for military pay.

What can you do?

#1 – Find the name and contact information of your State Representative and Senator. Go to https://iga.in.gov/ then under Information click on Find Your Legislator. This will show who your State and National representatives are.



#2 – Contact them and make sure they know who you are and that you are a voting *Veteran*. Talk to your local state representative about the Big Four priorities.






