3. You and / or your members can make a donation in any amount. We will recognize you and / or your members.

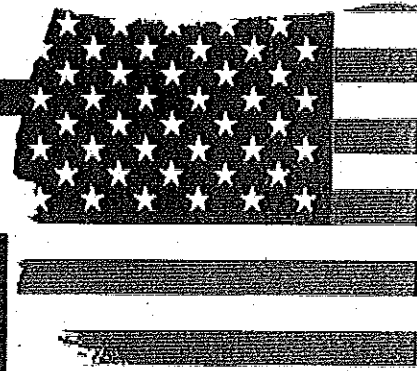
