2. **All officers** are encouraged to make every effort to renew the membership of each and every continuous member prior to their expiration. Reports showing members 30, 60, and 90 days from expiration can be obtained by the Post Quartermaster through the Online Membership System (OMS).
3. **Officers** who are annual members and fail to renew prior to their expiration date will be relieved of their officer position per section 215, 415, or 515 of National By-Laws.
4. **Commanders** are reminded that accurate and complete records shall be kept by all persons handling Post funds including the Club Manager and Bingo Chairman. These records shall be audited by Post Trustees in the same manner as Post Quartermaster and Adjutant records.

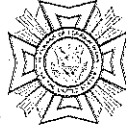



**Free services offered for active duty, reserve duty, and veteran members of the U.S. Army, Marine Corps., Navy, Air Force, Coast Guard, Public Health Service Commissioned Corps., National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's Officer Corps., with valid identification:**

- Up to two (2) pieces of checked baggage. Each bag must weigh under 100 lbs.
- No charge for oversized checked baggage. Maximum size is 115 linear inches in height + width + length.
- One (1) carry-on bag within Allegiant size limits.
- One (1) personal item within Allegiant size limits.
- Free boarding pass printing at the airport.
- Up to one (1) pet in cabin.
- Spouses and dependents may qualify for the same benefits **only if traveling on the same itinerary with the eligible military traveler.**
- Qualifying service members will be called to board early. \*
- Active and reserve military will not be charged a change or cancellation fee due to a change in orders. (To change or cancel an existing reservation active military personnel must contact Customer Care.)

*\*All passengers traveling on a single itinerary with a military member may board together when called to board early.*

To qualify for the benefits of the Allegiant Honors program, U.S. military members of the seven uniformed services and their dependents traveling on an Allegiant itinerary must show proof with one of the following government ID(s):

- DOD Common Access Card (CAC)
- Uniformed Services ID Card or driver's license with a veteran designation on it at the airport during check-in.
- DD Form 214
- DD Form 2
- DD Form 2765
- DD Form 1173-1 (dependents only if traveling with military honoree)
- Veteran ID card

## *Agricultural Career Certification & Internship Program for Military Veterans*

The **Indiana AgVets Certification and Internship Program** is an agricultural career training opportunity specifically for U.S. military veterans in Indiana or surrounding states. The program prepares participants for rewarding careers in production agriculture or agribusiness by providing specialized training (free of charge) tailored to the veteran's personal interests and career aspirations, and paid internships in a farm or agricultural service business.

Indiana AgVets is a project of Hoosier Uplands Economic Development Corporation, in cooperation with the AgrAbility Project at Purdue University. The program is supported by the United States Department of Agriculture's National Institute of Food and Agriculture (NIFA) Grant Number 2019-77028-29971.

***The primary goal of this project is to equip veterans with the skills and knowledge necessary to be successful in agricultural-related careers.***

- **Open to U.S. military veterans or current National Guard or Reserve members** (of any service branch) in Indiana and surrounding states
- Expenses-paid agricultural career training and certification programs
- Individualized training curriculum geared to each participant's career goals
- 8 week paid internship at Purdue University research farm, private farm, or agribusiness
- Support for disabilities and other challenges often faced by military veterans

### ***All participants will receive the following core training:***

- Introduction to the agricultural industry and agricultural careers
- Agricultural safety and health certification
- Commercial pesticide applicator Registered Technician certification
- Employment, entrepreneurship, and career instruction for veterans in agriculture
- **Paid internship**, with mentoring and job coaching

- Commercial drivers license
- Pork or Beef Quality Assurance certification
- Accredited Horticulturalist
- Master Naturalist
- Commercial Pesticide Applicator Category certification
