

GENERAL ORDERS #10

1 April 2021 2020-2021 Series

TO BE READ AT MEETINGS AND POSTED:

- 1. INSPECTIONS: District Commanders are asked to send the State Inspector an email with the corrective actions they have taken for discrepancies found during their annual District inspections. Cory.mahan.vfw@gmail.com
- 2. INSTALLING OFFICERS: Installing officers will see that the provisions of Section 216 of the National Bylaws and the Manual of Procedure are properly carried out and that all officers are members in good standing and qualified to hold office prior to installing Post officers for the current year. Post officers shall not be installed or assume the duties of their office until proof of eligibility has been submitted and carefully reviewed.

Post-Election Reports must be submitted following Post election of officers in April and no later than June 1 to the National Headquarters. It is highly encouraged all Post Quartermasters to use the online Election Report process featured in the Online Membership System (OMS). Post-Election Reports received electronically will be forwarded to the Department Headquarters.

3. VFW National Convention Registration: Section 222 of the Manual of Procedure states each Post will pay, in advance, a national convention registration fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25) which shall entitle the Post to a packet of convention information and materials and one identified registered delegate for the VFW National Convention. Each additional delegate attending the national convention will pay a ten dollars (\$10) delegate fee provided the Post has paid the mandated \$25 advance registration fee. All advance registrations should be mailed to the VFW National Headquarters, 406 W. 34th Street, Kansas City, MO 64111, ATTN: Convention Registration or you may register only by going to vfw.org.

- 4. VFW National Convention Housing: Indiana has been assigned the Hyatt Regency Baltimore Inner Harbor Hotel for the Baltimore, MD Convention. Room reservations/housing form are included with these General Orders and may also be found at www.vfw.org.
- 5. State Convention: Will be held at the Marriott East, Indianapolis, IN. The dates are 3 6 June 2021. Please make notes of these dates, making sure all Posts and Districts are up to date on all reports in OMS and monies due, as these WILL NOT be accepted during the convention. See attachment for Room Reservations and Banquet.
- 6. State Convention Delegates: State Convention Delegate list is attached. A Post is entitled to 1 delegate for 30 members or fraction thereof. Based on membership numbers as of 1 April 2021. Delegate fee to State is based on the 1 per 30 ratios plus one (1) for the Commander. If your membership is 187, that equals 6.24, rounded to 7 plus 1 for the Commander, for a total of 8 delegates. This product times the \$3.00 delegate fee equates to \$24.00 to State. Delegate fees are to be paid on or before 19 May 2021 to the Department Headquarters.
- 7. Admin Fees: Each Post will pay an administrative fee of \$1.00 for every NEW member attained from 1 July 2020 through the date of the Post-Election. Admin fees are to be paid on or before 19 May 2021 to the Department Headquarters.
- 8. District Convention: Pursuant to Section 403 of the National Bylaws and the Manual of Procedure, each District shall hold an annual District Convention for the purpose of electing District officers, such convention to held not less than ten (10) days nor more than seventy-five (75) days prior to the convening of the Department Convention. District officers shall not assume the duties of their office until the Department Commander is installed. District officers shall not be installed or assume the duties of their office until proof of eligibility has been submitted and properly reviewed in accordance with Section 416 of the Manual of Procedure.
- 9. **All State:** The nomination for All State Post Commander and Quartermaster is included in these General Orders. The deadline for submission for All State nominations and related

documentation is Noon on April 5, 2021. All material must be in hand at VFW State Headquarters at this time.

- 10. James Butters Award: The James Butters Award is an annual award that goes to a deserving Post Service Officer. The nomination form for this included within these documents. The deadline for submission is April 30, 2021. Submit nominations to the State Adjutant at VFW State Headquarters.
- 11. All-American Dashboard: All Post and District Adjutants need to update the Dashboard.
- 12. **VFW Service Office:** The VFW Service Office has 3 Service Officer vacancies available. Resumes (with a copy of DD-214) can be faxed, emailed, or mailed to the Department Headquarters. Please see attached document for more information.

NATIONAL CONVENTION "BUDDY" POPPY DISPLAY CONTEST

These guidelines have been designed to place emphasis on the purpose and effectiveness of the displays. It is suggested and recommended that Department (State) contests rule be established in a like form.

RULES

(1) Displays will be presented and judged in three categories:

CATEGORY 1. Public Promotion of Poppy Campaign (Window, booth, parade, poster displays, campaign promotions, etc.)

- (a) Displays must be designed for public exposure and must bear a message soliciting a donation for and wearing of the VFW Buddy Poppy.
- (b) At least one (1) of the poppies used in the display must be in its original form and color, with label attached.

CATEGORY 2. <u>Memorial or Inspirational Displays</u> (Wreaths, memorial tablets or plaques, patriotic or devotional themes)

- (a) Displays must be designed to honor the dead, to inspire devotion to God and Country, or to dramatize the activities supported by the Buddy Poppy.
- (b) At least one (1) of the poppies used in the display must be in its original form and color, with label attached.

- CATEGORY 3. <u>Artistic or Decorative Use of Poppies</u> (Post Home displays, table center- pieces, corsages, pictures, plaques, models, scenes, hats, novelty pieces, etc.)
 - (a) Any display not meeting the qualifications for Categories 1 or 2 shall automatically be entered in Category 3.
 - (b) At least one (1) of the poppies used in the display must be in its original form and color, with label attached.
- (2) Departments purchasing over 250,000 poppies will be allowed two (2) displays in each of the three (3) categories for the National Display Contest ... all others will be allowed one (1) display in each of the three (3) categories, no deviations.
- (3) The National Programs Committee shall have no responsibility in setting up, taking down or returning displays.
- (4) Displays shall be set up in space provided in the convention facility. Prior to setting up the display, the responsible person must register with the Buddy Poppy desk and complete an entry form (unless one was forwarded earlier, approved by Department) which will show the category of competition, the number of poppies used, the purpose of the display, the Post and/or Auxiliary number and location, and the name of the person who will dismantle and remove the display at the close of the convention. (Please be advised, all displays must be removed by 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday or it will be disposed of by convention center personnel.)
- (5) Displays <u>may or may not</u> be accompanied by a white card, not to exceed 4 inches by 6 inches in size, on which is lettered in black ink an explanation of the theme for the display or other information of interest to the viewers or the judges.
- (6) Post name, number, city or state (including the shape of your state) may <u>not</u> be visible on the displays. Failure to comply will result in disqualification.
- (7) (NEW) Any use of non VFW trademarks or copyrighted material on your display is prohibited. These include but are not limited to names, logos, audio/visual graphics, images and/or props. The Buddy Poppy logo and name is authorized but use of any other trademark or copyrighted material will disqualify the entry from being displayed or judged.





"That's All Brother"

Visiting Terra Haute Regional Airport, 12 -15 Apr 21



Over 75 years ago, on June 6, 1944, That's All, Brother led the main airborne invasion of Normandy. Piloted by Lt. Col John Donalson, the plane led over 800 C-47s that dropped over 13,000 paratroopers into a battle that changed the course of mankind. 75 years later, we were able to bring this great airplane back to the skies over Normandy for the commemoration of the 75th anniversary of D-Day. After serving on D-Day, and in Operations Dragoon, Market Garden, Repulse, and Varsity, the airplane returned to the United States and was sold to the civilian market in 1945. During the course of many owners over the next several decades, the historical significance of the airplane was lost and it was eventually sold to be scrapped. Fortunately, two historians from the United States Air Force discovered that this historic airplane was lying in a boneyard in Wisconsin. The Commemorative Air Force was able to acquire the airplane, and through a large group of donors and volunteers, restore the airplane to flying status. "That's All, Brother" has been restored to its 1944 condition, including its D-Day paint scheme along with a thorough historic interior restoration.






For this month's Commander's Challenge, we will be measuring total increase in membership in the month of April. The top THREE Posts in each Division will receive an award for their achievement:
