On November 8, 2021 VFW Post 2714 voted to propose the following by-law changes at the State Convention.

Article XI

Big 10 Conference

Change section 1 to the following:

Section 1. The Department Commander, Sr. Vice Commander, Jr. Vice Commander, Quartermaster and Adjutant shall be ex-officio delegates to the Big 10 Conference.

Renumber section 2 and 3 to 3 and 4 respectively.

Add Section 2 as follows:

Section 2. In the event that the Quartermaster and Adjutant are filled by the same person the Jr. Past Commander will be the replacement delegate.

Article VI

Department Districts

Change the following districts:

District No. 7: The counties of Clay, Owen, Morgan, Johnson, Sullivan, Greene, Monroe, Knox, Davies and Martin.

District No. 8: The counties of Pike, Dubois, Crawford, Harrison, Floyd, Clark, Posey, Vanderburgh, Warrick, Spencer, Perry and Gibson.

At the start of this operating year, 2021-22 for the Department of Indiana, Veterans of Foreign Wars, the Department Commander commissioned “a redistricting committee” to develop a process that will permit an effective and standardized method for addressing the issue of redistricting within this Department. After months of research, meetings, discussions and even simulations, this committee has produced a recommended “by-law” amendment to the Department’s By-Laws. This proposed amendment will ensure the maximum amount of input and control by the membership of the Department of Indiana, while also limiting the effects of personal trivialities and petty jealousies when it becomes necessary to address the redistricting of the Department. As the current organization of the Departments eleven districts were established more than a century ago, themselves based on congressional districts and passenger rail traffic patterns that no longer exists, this recommended “by-law” amendment will also provide an opportunity for the members to have an opportunity...and the Department to have the responsibility...to regularly address the composition of the districts every decade. This recommended “by-law” amendment is as follows:

Article VI

Sec. 5 The Department Commander for operating years 2XX5-2XX6 (every ten years), will form a “Redistricting Committee” which shall be comprised only of the Department Commander, Department Quartermaster, ALL District Commanders, and the Department Commander’s appointee who will act as Committee Chair. Once formed at the start of the 2XX5-2XX6 operating year, the District Commanders will represent the interests of not only the members of their respective Districts, but all Department membership collectively, while the Department officers and appointees will act to guide the Committee through to its conclusion to ensure that the requirements and expectations of the Committee are fulfilled.

The Committee will be required to present three (3) proposals to the Council of Administration no later than the March (2XX6) Council of Administration meeting of the 2XX5-2XX6, year as a courtesy, and to the membership by way of the final State Meeting or Conference before the State Convention. The proposals are to consist of one of each of the following: a proposal that

includes a decrease in the number of Districts in the state, a proposal that includes an increase in the number of Districts in the state, and a proposal that maintains the number of Districts but includes changes of the Posts within the Districts themselves. The proposals must adhere to all Department By-Laws, and they must ensure each District contains a minimum of eight (8) Posts per District.

Committee members shall take into consideration such matters as Posts that have been established or disestablished since the previous "Redistricting Year", travel times within a District (existing or proposed), time zones, Post membership populations, and performance participation of individual Posts (such as elections, membership, inspections).

Upon the completion of the mandated proposals and their presentation, the three proposals will be voted upon by the membership, during the Department of Indiana Convention. Two balloting events shall take place. The Proposal with the fewest votes during the first ballot will be eliminated from the second. All present qualifying Posts are to be allowed to cast a vote for the first balloting. The first proposal to receive a two-thirds majority of the present and qualifying possible votes available at the Convention during the second ballot, will be accepted as a new By-Law. If neither proposal receives a two-thirds majority during the second ballot, no redistricting will occur that decade.

If two (2) Districts have fewer than eight (8) posts, during ANY operating year (for example, 2XX9-2XX0), the Department Commander of the next operating year (2XX0-2XX1), MUST establish a Redistricting Committee earlier than normally established, which will follow the same rules, guidelines, and obligations of a regularly scheduled Redistricting Committee. However, during the second ballot, the proposal that has most votes will be enacted, due to the proposals having the required minimum of eight (8) Posts in each District, and the status quo not able to be sustained.

All properties and monies held by the districts, belong to the Department of Indiana, and will be appropriated and disbursed at the discretion of the Department's Finance Committee and are not a subject to this By-Law.

The "renumbering" of the districts, will occur in one of two ways:

A The new proposed numbers are included in the redistricting proposals

or

B New numbers will be assigned by lottery during "good of the order" at the same Business Session of the Department Convention.
