**TO BE READ AT MEETINGS AND POSTED:**

1. **State Headquarters will be closed** Thursday, 1 January 2026 for New Years and Monday, 19 January 2025 to observe Martin Luther King Jr. Day.
2. **Commander on all levels** are reminded that according to Section 105 of the National Bylaws, a member whose dues are unpaid after their anniversary date ceases to be a member in good standing and loses all rights of membership in the Veterans of Foreign Wars. They shall not attend meetings or conventions, and shall not participate in Post, County Council, District, Department or National functions.
3. **Per Section 218, Manual of Procedure**, the Post and District Trustee's Report of Audit for the quarter ending 31 December 2025 is due to the State Adjutant **not later than 31 January 2026**.
4. **January 2025 District Meetings**. Schedule is attached to these General Orders.
5. **Indiana Military Veteran's Legislative Day at the State House** will be 12 January 2026 in the Rotunda of the Indiana State Capitol located at 200 W. Washington St., Indianapolis, IN. The overall event is intended to open communication channels between Indiana Reserve Component, active-duty military veterans and families with their Indiana State Senators and Representatives regarding military and veteran specific legislation moving through the Indiana General Assembly during the 2026 legislative session.
6. **State Commander Ferguson and State Auxiliary President Jessie Davenport's Testimonial** will be at VFW Post 6246: 654 S 9ths St. Noblesville, IN on Saturday, 25 April 2026. Tickets will be \$20.00.
7. **Section 803 of the Manual of Procedure Alternative Cap** is on sale now at the VFW Store. This is a baseball-style cap, black in color, lettered with VFW initials, Post numerals, state, rank of office (when applicable), Veterans of Foreign Wars and bearing the Cross of Malta may be worn by members other than officers during meetings of the Post and District. Lettering on each cap shall be in gold.

The trim on the front of the bill shall be either gold, green, red, or silver, corresponding to the official braid colors for the respective organizational echelon.

The baseball-style cap shall be an alternative to, but not a replacement for the regulation overseas cap and shall not be worn in place of the regulation cap at formal ceremonies, when in business attire, or at events where the regulation cap is prescribed.

8. **2026 VFW Day of Service** kicks off on 1 May 2026, with events taking place throughout the month of May. Posts are encouraged to start planning now – May will be here before we know it.

9. **The Online Membership System (OMS)** will shut down at **4:00pm CST on 31 December 2025**. Any transactions submitted through OMS on 31 December before the shutdown will be posted to Memstats and Post Query later that evening and will be available for viewing the morning of **6 January 2026**.





We trace our roots back to 1899 when veterans of the Spanish-American War (1898) and the Philippine Insurrection (1899-1902) founded local organizations to secure rights and benefits for their service. Many arrived home wounded or sick. There was no medical care or veterans' pension for them, and they were left to care for themselves. In their misery, some of these veterans banded together and formed organizations that would eventually band together and become known as the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States.






