

Comrades,

Memorial Day is a day for Americans to honor and mourn the military personnel who have died in the performance of their military duty while serving in the United States Armed Forces. Thank you for honoring our fallen by placing flags at the cemeteries, participating in parades and for all the Memorial Day ceremonies.

The 2020-2021 year is almost complete. By the time you read this, we will have less than 30 days left for this fiscal year. The membership year ends on 30 June. At the time of this writing Indiana was at 97.68% in membership. We are 2<sup>nd</sup> in the Big Ten Conference to Nebraska and 18<sup>th</sup> nationally. Indiana needs just 657 new/reinstate members to make 100%. That may seem like a lot but this is truly doable.

We now have three Districts at 100% in membership. Since the beginning of May we have increased from 36 to 51 posts at 100% or greater. None of this would be possible without all of our membership recruiters. Congratulations to our top three recruiters Judy King—100, Kenneth Lange—48 and Richard Lineberry—43 new members.

FYI: If your post has made it to 100% in membership you may be eligible for "All State". Please take a look at the April General Orders for the All State Post/Quartermaster nominee form. You may still submit this form, you will not receive your hats at the State Convention, but you will receive them at a later date.

2. Medical experience/anatomy/training is strongly encouraged.
3. Must be a VFW member in good standing or join VFW prior to hire.
4. Must possess computer skills and have experience with Microsoft products.
5. Must possess excellent people/communication skills.
6. Must possess excellent writing skills.
7. Willing to travel several times a year to National VFW and training events.
8. Willing to travel around the State on veteran outreach events.
9. Must possess excellent critical thinking and analytical skills.
10. Must pass a background check.
11. Must not have any history of felony convictions or serious misdemeanors.
12. Must possess excellent ability to read, interpret, and apply the Code of Federal Regulations, and other regulatory laws and manuals published by VA, Federal and State Government.

**Duties and responsibilities:** All training will be provided by the VFW. Once accredited by the VA's Counsel, the Service Officer is responsible for accurately assisting all veterans, their survivors, and other valid claimants in maximizing their legal entitlements to all State and Federal veteran's benefits. This includes knowing, understanding, and providing detailed information on all said benefits. Where assistance is not available through the VFW, the Service Officer must maintain contact information on a myriad of State and Federal services, such as homelessness, financial aid, housing,

counseling, and many others, then refer clients to those services. The Service Officer is responsible for providing clients with accurate legal advice in the pursuit of VA Compensation and Pension benefits, to include prosecution with the Board of Veterans Appeals (BVA). Where legally possible, this includes interviewing the client, reviewing all available documentary evidence, then creating a valid legal argument in favor of the benefit, and assisting the client make said argument with the BVA. Where no legal argument is possible, the Service Officer will assist the client in presenting his/her information and testimony before the BVA.

# VA Community Emergency Care Information for Veterans

In most instances, Veterans are eligible to receive Department of Veterans Affairs (VA)-authorized emergency care at an in-network facility if VA is notified of the emergent event within 72 hours. The VA medical center (VAMC) nearest to a Veteran's emergent event can identify in-network emergency care providers.

Veterans do not need to check with VA before going to an emergency department in the community or calling an ambulance. During a medical emergency, VA encourages all Veterans to seek immediate medical attention without delay.

To simplify and streamline this emergency care notification process, VA established a national emergency care contact center.

The Emergency Care Centralized Notification Center allows community providers to report instances of a Veteran presenting to a community emergency department. It offers simplified access to VA for care coordination, eligibility determination and payment authorization information. Centralized notification standardizes communication, documentation and collaboration between VA and community providers.

## General Information

VA should be notified within 72 hours of the start of an emergent event that a Veteran has sought emergency care at an in-network facility. This notification ensures VA can authorize the care. This step also assists VA in coordinating the Veteran's transfer to a VAMC and additional care, and ensures that the requirements for VA to pay for the care are met.

For each emergent episode of care, treating community providers will receive authorization decision information and, if applicable, directions on how to submit claims. Failure to notify VA of care rendered through an in-network community facility prevents VA from authorizing the emergency treatment and prevents claims and payments from being made through one of VA's third-party administrators.

If notification is made to a local VA medical facility the notification will be referred to the centralized intake for action.
