TO BE READ AT MEETINGS AND POSTED:

- 1. Installing Officers are directed to see to it that the Post Election Report forms have been completed and submitted to National Headquarters. If a Post Election Report form has not been forwarded to National Headquarters at the time of installation, the installing officer shall complete and forward such report at the time of the installation of Post Officers no later than 1 June. We encourage all Post Quartermasters to use the online Election Report process featured in the Online Membership System (OMS). Post Election Reports received electronically will be forwarded to the Department Headquarters. Additionally, Section 413 of the National By-Laws requires that a properly completed District Election Report be submitted to National Headquarters prior to the convening of the Department Convention.
- 2. Post, District Commanders, Adjutants, and Quartermasters are reminded of the requirements of Sections 216, 416 and 516 of the Manual of Procedure with regard to proof of eligibility for all newly elected and appointed officers. Elected and appointed officers shall not be installed or assume the duties of their office until proof of eligibility has been submitted and properly reviewed. Failure or refusal to submit proof of eligibility within thirty (30) days of election or appointment shall result in the office being declared vacant.
- 3. Post Quartermasters are reminded that Form 103 & 104 are due annually to your township/county assessor. Form should be due not later than 15 May 2023.
- 4. State Convention will be held at the Marriott East, Indianapolis, IN 8 11 June 2023. The Finance Meeting will be at 2pm on 8 June 2023. Please make note of these important dates, making sure that all Posts and Districts are up to date on all reports and monies due to Districts/State/National.
- All Commanders/Quartermasters: In accordance with Sec. 213 of the National By-Laws, Any Post in arrears for any financial

obligations to County Council (if applicable), District, Department and National for fees, dues, poppy money, supply money, failing to have the Quartermaster properly bonded in accordance with Section 703, failing to ensure the Post is properly insured in accordance with Section 709, failing to submit properly completed quarterly Post Trustees Report of Audit, Post-Election Report for the ensuing year, or other obligations, shall be deprived of all representation in County Council and District meetings; County Council, District, Department and National Conventions. Such representation shall be restored promptly upon proper adjustment of such deficiencies.

ALL DEFICIENCIES MUST BE CORRECTED WITH THE STATE ADJUTANT BEFORE NOON ON FRIDAY 9 JUNE 2023.



At state level I served as Quartermaster.


