GENERAL ORDERS #4

TO BE READ AT MEETINGS AND POSTED:

- 1. Post Quartermaster Bonds obtained from the Department through National expired on 31 August 2020. Application for bond renewal was attached to August General Orders. Please get these turned in to the Department Headquarters ASAP.
- 2. Members are reminded that under the subscription dues model, an annual member dues expire on the last day of the month of which they paid the previous year. Annual members are encouraged to renew their dues prior to their anniversary month to avoid a lapse in continuous membership. Officers and committee members, whose membership is not in good standing by reason to pay current dues, by the end of their anniversary month, shall forfeit eligibility to hold any office the remained of the administrative year.
- 3. Organizations exempt from income tax under Section 501c of the Internal revenue Code are generally required to file Form 990 by the 15th day of the fifth month following the close of their accounting fiscal year. For the current IRS requirements (beginning on or after January 1), if the organization's annual gross receipts are normally more than \$50,000, the organization must file Form 990 or 990-EZ. Small tax-exempt organizations whose annual gross receipts are normally \$50,000 or less are required to electronically submit Form990-N, also known as the E-Postcard. There is no penalty assessment for late filling the E-Postcard, but an organization that fails to file required information returns for three consecutive years will automatically lose its tax-exempt status. The revocation of the organization's tax-exempt status will not take place until the filing due date of the third year,

Gross receipts are considered to be normally less than \$50,000 if the organizations:

a. Has been in existence for 1 year or less and received, or donors have pledged to give, \$75,000 or less during its first taxable year.

- b. Has been in existence between 1 and 3 years and averaged \$60,000 or less in gross receipts during each of its first two tax years: and
- c. Is at least 3 years old and averaged \$50,000 or less in gross receipts for the immediately preceding 3 tax years (including the year for which the calculations are being made).

If annual gross receipts are normally more than \$50,000, the organization must file Form 990 or 990-EZ. For the current IRS requirements, if an organization has gross receipts less than \$200,000 and total assets less than \$500,000, it may file form 990-EZ. However, if either gross receipts or total assets are above those limits, Form 990 must be filed.

For purposes of filing requirements, gross receipts include: total contributions; gifts and grants; program service revenue; membership dues and assessments; gross investment income (including interest, dividends, gross rents, and other investment income); gross income for the sale of assets other than inventory; gross income from special fundraising events; gross sales net of return allowances; and any other revenue.

IRS regulations require that all tax-exempt organizations make both their Application for Exemption and 990's for the last three years available for public inspection at their principal office and provide copies in response to written requests, subject to the payment of reasonable fees. There are substantial penalties for violation of these regulations.

- 4. Post Commanders: Section 218 of the Manual of Procedure requires that the Post Commander shall see that the Post Trustees Reports of Audit are properly prepared and submitted each quarter to the State Ouartermaster.
- 5. Post (and District) Trustee Report of Audit for the quarter ended 30 September 2020 is due to the State Headquarters not later than 31 October 2020. Post not in compliance can be put on suspension.
- 6. District Quartermasters are directed to Article VI of the Department By-Laws that they shall submit to the State Quartermaster within sixty (60) days after their District Convention, a copy of the District Budge for the ensuing year.
- 7. The State Headquarters Does Not have a PO Box please send correspondence to 9555 E. 59^{TH} Street Indianapolis, IN 46216.

- 8. Since the visit to the National Home for Children was cancelled due to COVID-19 during the Fall Conference on 24 October 2020 there will be a Parade of Checks in the memo line please write General Fund.
- 9. Message for Jerry Blake State Judge Advocate: Hello everyone. Hope everyone is enjoying each other's company while we find our way through this COVID-10. Wanted to remind everyone to please take care of yourselves and take care of people around you. Looks like the Governor is finally opening up the state for more activities take advantage of this situation, get back into our post and get y9ur good work done for other veterans. 
