MEMBERSHIP PROGRAM

INCENTIVES

"OPEN TO ALL MEMBERS" EARLY DUES PAYMENT INCENTIVES

ALL DATA MUST BE CONFIRMED IN VFW NATIONAL MEMSTATS

Any member who becomes a Legacy Life member or advances a level (Bronze to Silver or Silver to Gold) will be placed in a drawing. If paying on an installment plan, the plan must be completely paid to be eligible. If a Legacy Life member advances multiple levels they will have an entry for each level they advance. First drawn receives \$200.00, second drawn receives \$250.00, and the third drawn receives \$350.00. The drawing will be at the 2023 State Convention.

Any member who joins as a Life Member, converts to a Life Member, or a reinstate member who converts to Life Member will be placed in a drawing. If paying on an installment plan the plan must be completely paid to be eligible. First drawn receives \$100.00, second drawn receives \$150.00, and the third drawn receives \$250.00. The drawing will be at the 2023 State Convention.

Any continuous member, new member or newly reinstated member who pays their dues by October 14, 2022 will have their name put into a drawing for \$100.00. Unless drawn their name will remain eligible for the next drawing.

Any continuous member, new member or newly reinstated member who pays their dues by November 18. 2022 will have their name put into the drawing for \$100.00. Unless drawn their name will remain eligible for the next drawing.

Any continuous member, new member or newly reinstated member who pays their dues by December 29, 2022 will have their name put into the drawing for \$100.00. Unless drawn their name will remain eligible for the next drawing.

Any continuous member, new member or newly reinstated member who pays their dues by January 27, 2023 will have their name put into the drawing for \$100.00.

"OPEN TO ALL MEMBERS" RECRUITER INCENTIVES

All members in good standing are eligible for Department Recruiter Awards – recruited members must be Department of Indiana members. Deadline on this award is June 1, 2023. Recruiters will receive their awards and be recognized at the State Convention.

- 100 NEW OR REINSTATE MEMBERS WILL RECEIVE A \$500 STIPEND TO THE NATIONAL CONVENTION

These awards are cumulative, and will be presented at the very next Department meeting after level is met. In summary if you recruit 100 new or reinstated members for the Department of Indiana you will receive all awards listed above, a cash total of \$1325.00. If you receive another stipend to the National Convention, you will receive the Recruiter Award for 75, and 100 in CASH, but you must attend National Convention to receive the cash award.

If paying on an installment plan, the plan must be completely paid to be eligible. The Post will receive \$100.00 and will be recognized at Spring Conference and Banquet.

HIGHEST PERCENTAGE IN MEMBERSHIP

The top 3 Post by Division in membership percentage on October 27, 2022 will be put into a drawing for \$150.00 and will be recognized at Fall Conference .

The Post having the highest percentage in membership on December 29, 2022 will receive \$150.00, two banquet tickets for the Spring Banquet and will be recognized at Spring Conference and Banquet.

The Post having the highest percentage in membership on January 27, 2023 will receive \$100.00, two banquet tickets for the Spring Banquet and will be recognized at Spring Conference and Banquet.

100% IN MEMBERSHIP

Post achieving 100% in membership prior to December 29, 2022 will be put in a drawing for \$300.00 and will be recognized at Spring Conference and Banquet.

All Post achieving 100% in membership prior to December 29, 2022 will receive two banquet tickets for the Spring Banquet and will be recognized at Spring Conference and Banquet.

The leading Post Commander by Division whose Post has at least 5 new or reinstate members and has 100% membership by June 1, 2023 will receive \$200.00 and will be formally recognized at the State Convention.

The District having the largest increase in Legacy Life Members or Legacy Life members who advance a level (Bronze to Silver or Silver to Gold) by March 17, 2022, minimum of 4, will receive \$100.00 and will be recognized at Spring Conference and Banquet.

HIGHEST PERCENTAGE IN MEMBERSHIP

The District with the highest percentage of membership by October 27, 2022 will receive \$250.00 towards their hospitality room and will be recognized at Fall Conference.

The District with the highest percentage of membership, with at least 90% +1, by November 15, 2022 will receive \$200.00, four banquet tickets for the Spring Banquet and will be recognized at Spring Conference and Banquet.

Any District with at least 90% +1, by December 29, 2022 will receive four banquet tickets for the Spring Banquet and will be recognized at Spring Conference and Banquet.

1. ALL STATE LETTERS

The All State Letters are to encourage you to talk with comrades who have been Post Commanders:

The All State Post Packet must include the entry form, along with any other supporting

The Post must achieve 100% in membership by June 30, 2023. Plus the following requirements:

- Have recovered at least 1 reinstate.
- Have recruited at least 1 new member.

ALL STATE POST PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

The requirements for All Sate Post must be completed by June 30, 2023. For a Post to be recognized and receive their awards at the State Convention it will be necessary for the Post to meet the All State requirements by April 21, 2023. The packet must be at Department HQ by 12:00pm (noon) of April 24, 2023. Post who complete the All State requirements after April 21, 2023 will receive their recognition and awards at the 2023 Fall Conference, packet must be at Department HQ July 7, 2023. Post Commander and Post Quartermaster must serve a complete term to be eligible for All State honors, exceptions must be approved by Department Commander prior to submission of All State Post packet.

The All State Post program is based on point system, to achieve All State you will need a total of 2500 points out of the 3125 available. The All State entry form has the different point values for each requirement, a score sheet is available for your convenience.

6. POST STEWARDSHIP

To ensure the Post is prepared for the future the following good stewardship items must be completed:

- Post Inspection Post Inspection must be completed prior to March 15, 2023 and any deficiencies must be corrected by April 7, 2023 or have a detailed plan to correct.

- Have recruited at least 3 new members.

- All properly scheduled Department Council of Administration meetings.
- Must attend all of the following Department events School of Instruction, Fall Conference, Winter C of A, Spring Conference or Department Convention.

4. Loyalty Day

The District must plan and have a Loyalty Day event.

5. VFW PROGRAMS

The District must show participation in the following:

- Voice of Democracy at least one entry submitted to the Department
- Patriot's Pen at least one entry submitted to the Department
